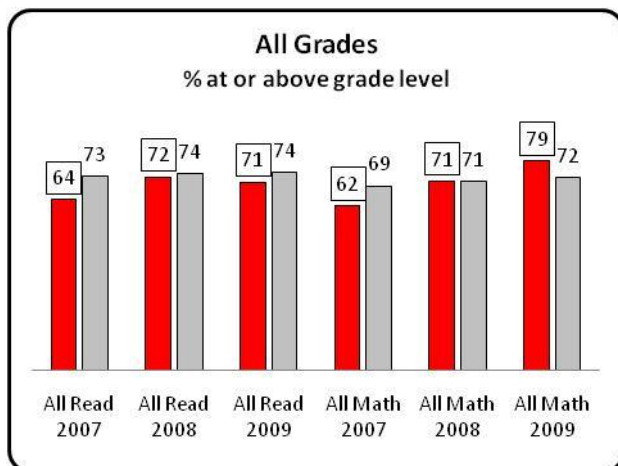
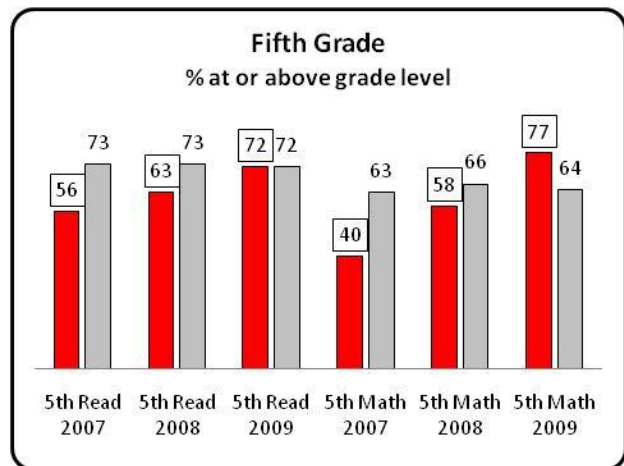
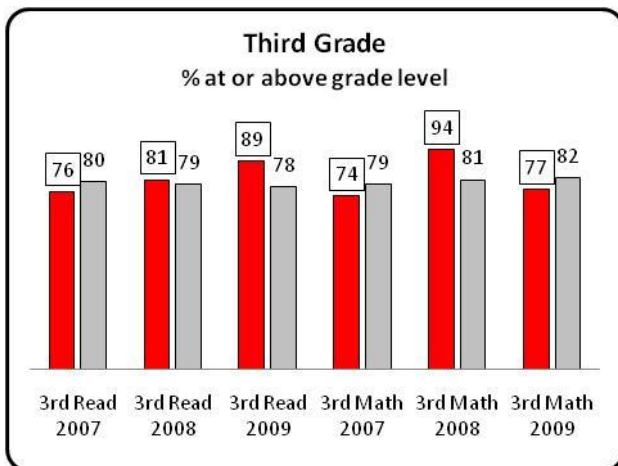


King Elementary - Deer River 391 Students (Grades K-6)

The Minnesota Business Partnership presented King Elementary School in Deer River with a Minnesota's Future Award, recognizing the school's success in raising overall student performance and closing the achievement gap between white, minority and low-income students. Overall, King Elementary students posted reading and math scores that were on par with or above the statewide average over the past three years. Meanwhile, the school's Native American and low-income students demonstrated substantial improvement over the past three years. The Minnesota's Future Award includes a \$10,000 cash grant and two new computers, courtesy of Ceridian Corp., Red Wing Shoe Company, Qwest and IBM.

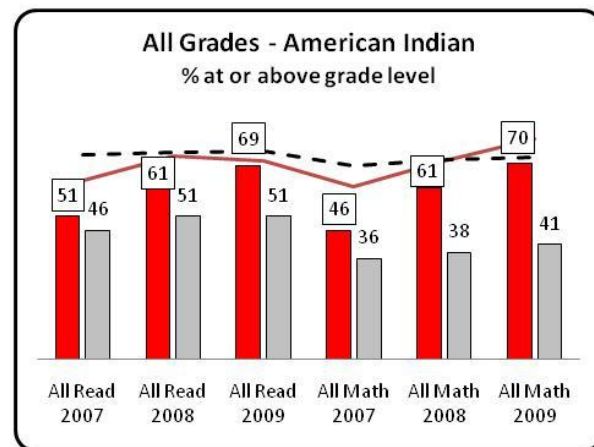
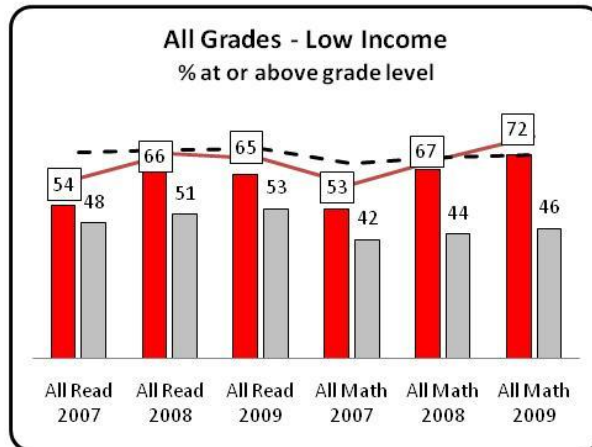
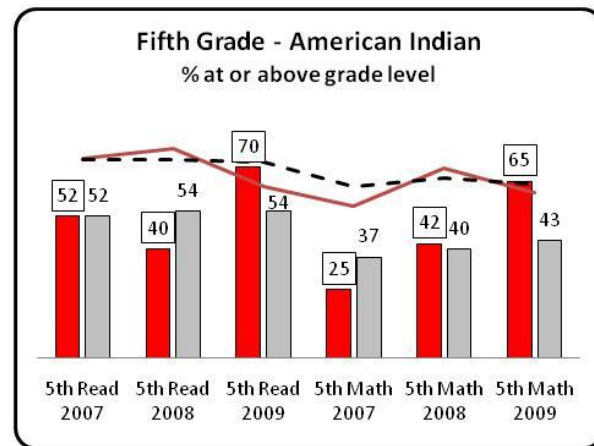
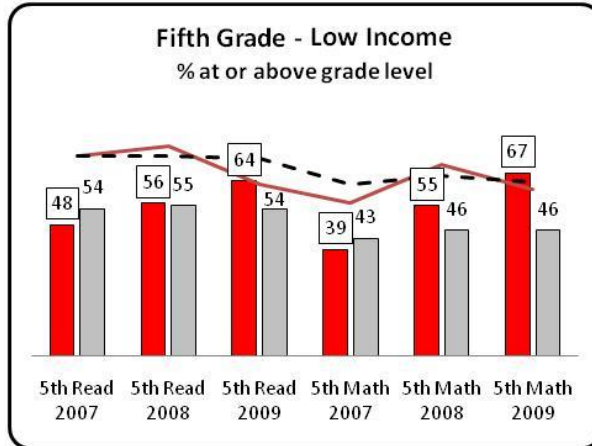
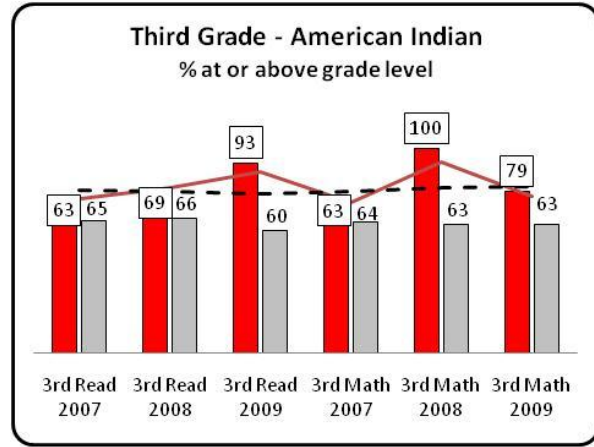
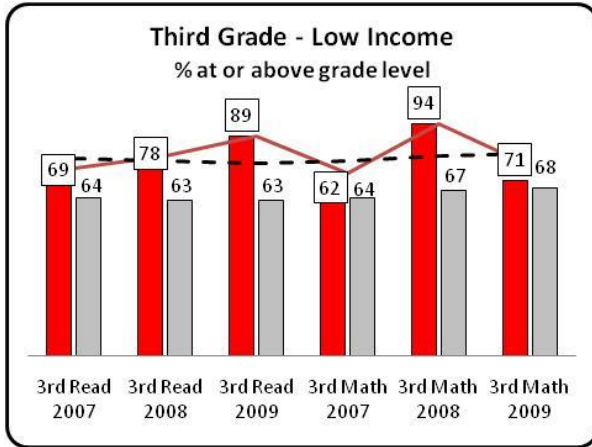
